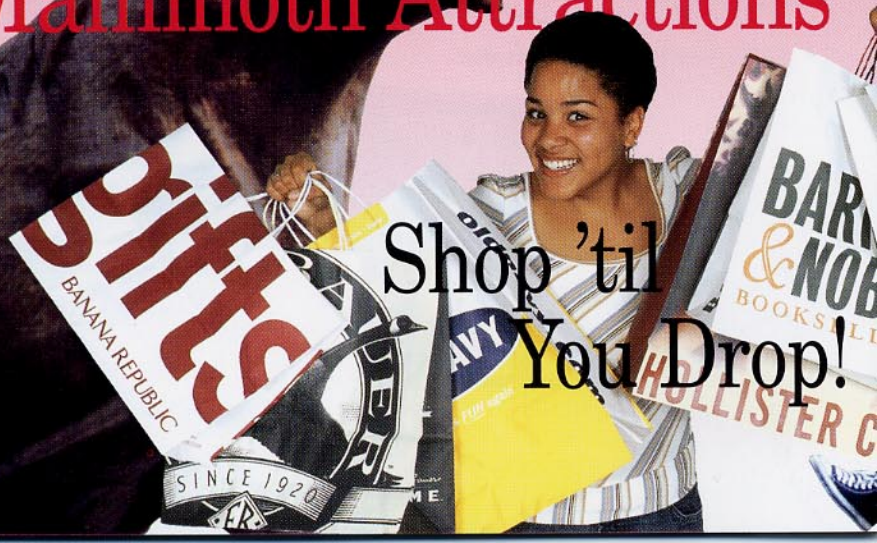

GETTING AROUND LINCOLN

DIRECTIONS: All compass directions are relative to the Van Brunt Visitors Center on City Campus.

- **HISTORIC HAYMARKET**
— Take “Q” Street west in the right-hand lane past 9th Street.
- **WESTFIELD SHOPPINGTOWN**
Gateway Mall area—Take “O” Street east past 56th street. The mall is on the north side of “O” Street.
- **SOUTHPOINTE PAVILIONS** outdoor shopping area—Take 27th Street south five miles from “O” Street to Pine Lake Road. The Mall is on the east side of 27th Street.

HINTS:

- **“O” STREET** is Lincoln's main east-west street. It divides the north and south numerical streets.
- **DOWNTOWN LINCOLN** is mostly one-way streets, alternating direction.
- **CAPITOL PARKWAY WEST, CAPITOL PARKWAY** and **NORMAL BOULEVARD** are the same street with three different names at different locations.
